Park Acquisition: As part of the DNR Grant a survey and title search is required. Motion by Holzheuer seconded by Helms to contract with Spicer for the surveying and title search for the park acquisition. Roll call vote: Ayes; Bassi, Bielby, Holzheuer, Helms, Lewis. Nays; None. Motion carried.

Capital Conf. Motion by Bielby seconded by Bassi to approve the Supervisor to attend Capital conf. in Lansing on April 21. Roll call vote: Ayes; Bielby, Helms, Holzheuer, Bassi, Lewis. Nays; None. Motion carried.

Library shelving: The Library is eligible for a grant of \$20,000 for new shelving. The shelving that is needed to finish this project would cost an additional \$9,000. Motion by Bassi seconded by Helms to pay the additional \$9,000.00. Roll call vote: Ayes; Helms, Bielby, Bassi, Holzheuer, Lewis. Nays; None. Motion carried.
